Introduction and Acknowledgements

This is the 38th version of the Mountain States Poll. Originally the Eastern Montana College Poll, Dr. Craig Wilson began the first version of the Poll in 1989. Using phone numbers provided by Scientific Telephone Samples with the random digit dialing technique, we collected 251 responses. For the online responses, Centiment used a quota sampling method, which recorded 603 responses. This brought our total number of responses to 854 with a margin of error of 3.35. Responses were recorded from October 3-15, 2025. Various subgroups will have larger margins of error. Census data was used to weight the responses. The Mountain States Poll was funded by the Office of the Provost, College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences, and the Department of Social Sciences and Cultural Studies at Montana State University Billings.

I would like to give special thanks to my department for their ongoing support, particularly our Department Chair, Dr. Paul Pope, and Program Coordinator Glenda Holbrook. I am eternally grateful for the guidance of Dr. Jessie Perius in the College of Business for getting the Poll up and running.





1. Did you vote in the 2024 presidential election?





2. Which US Presidential candidate did you vote for?




